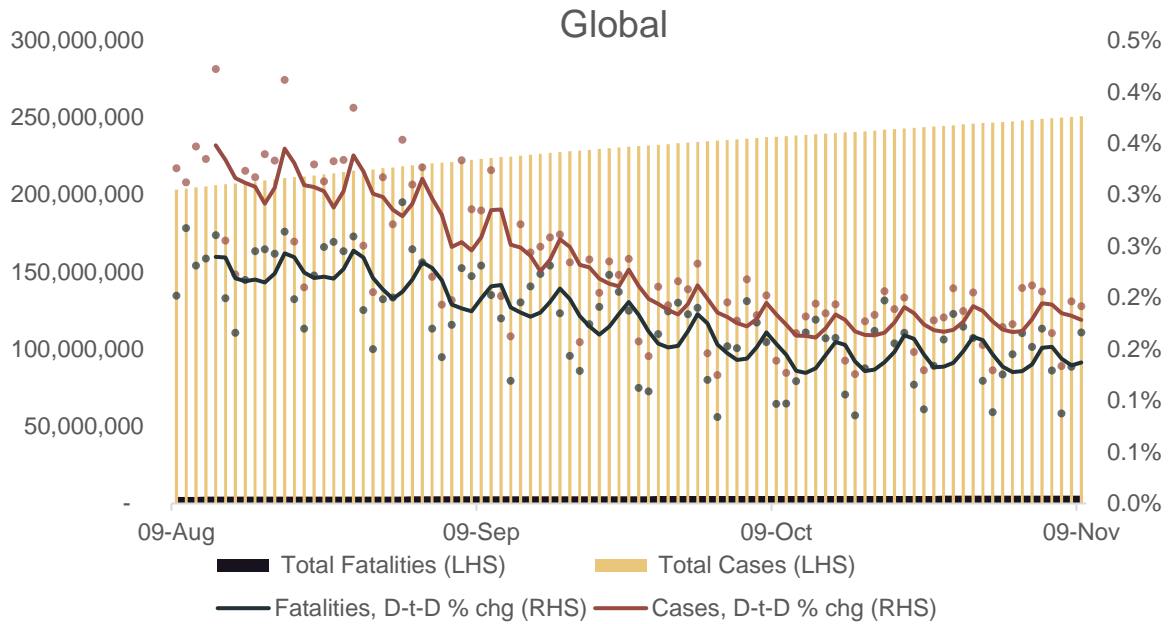

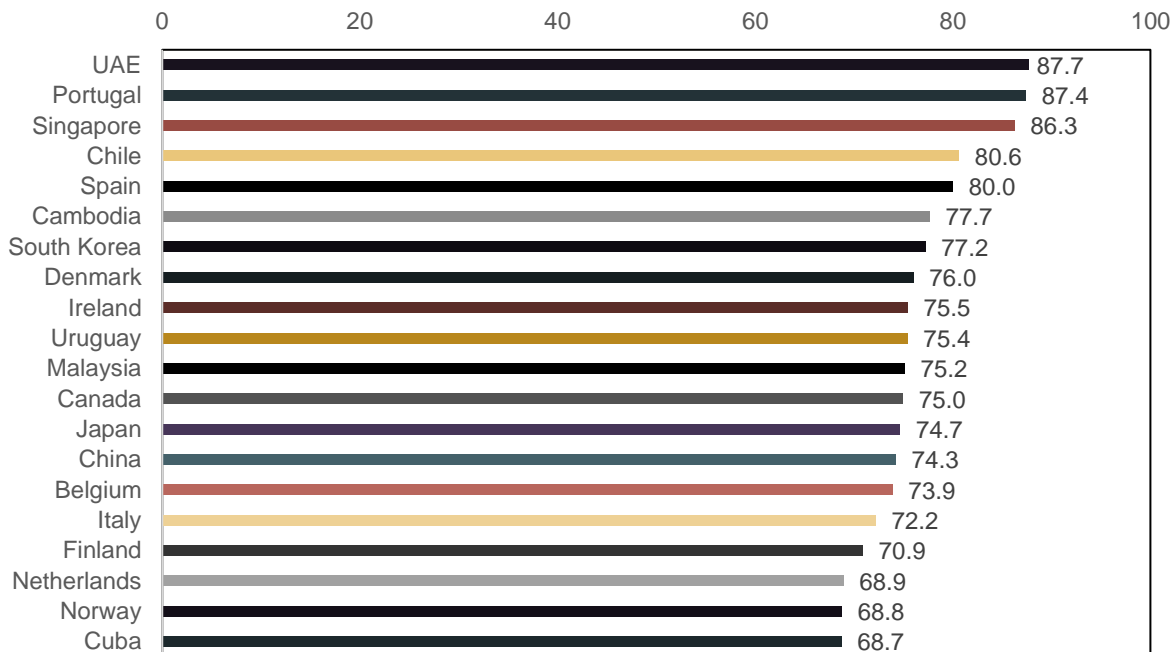

Chart 1. COVID-19 Cases and Fatalities, Nominal and % Chg Day-to-Day (5dma)



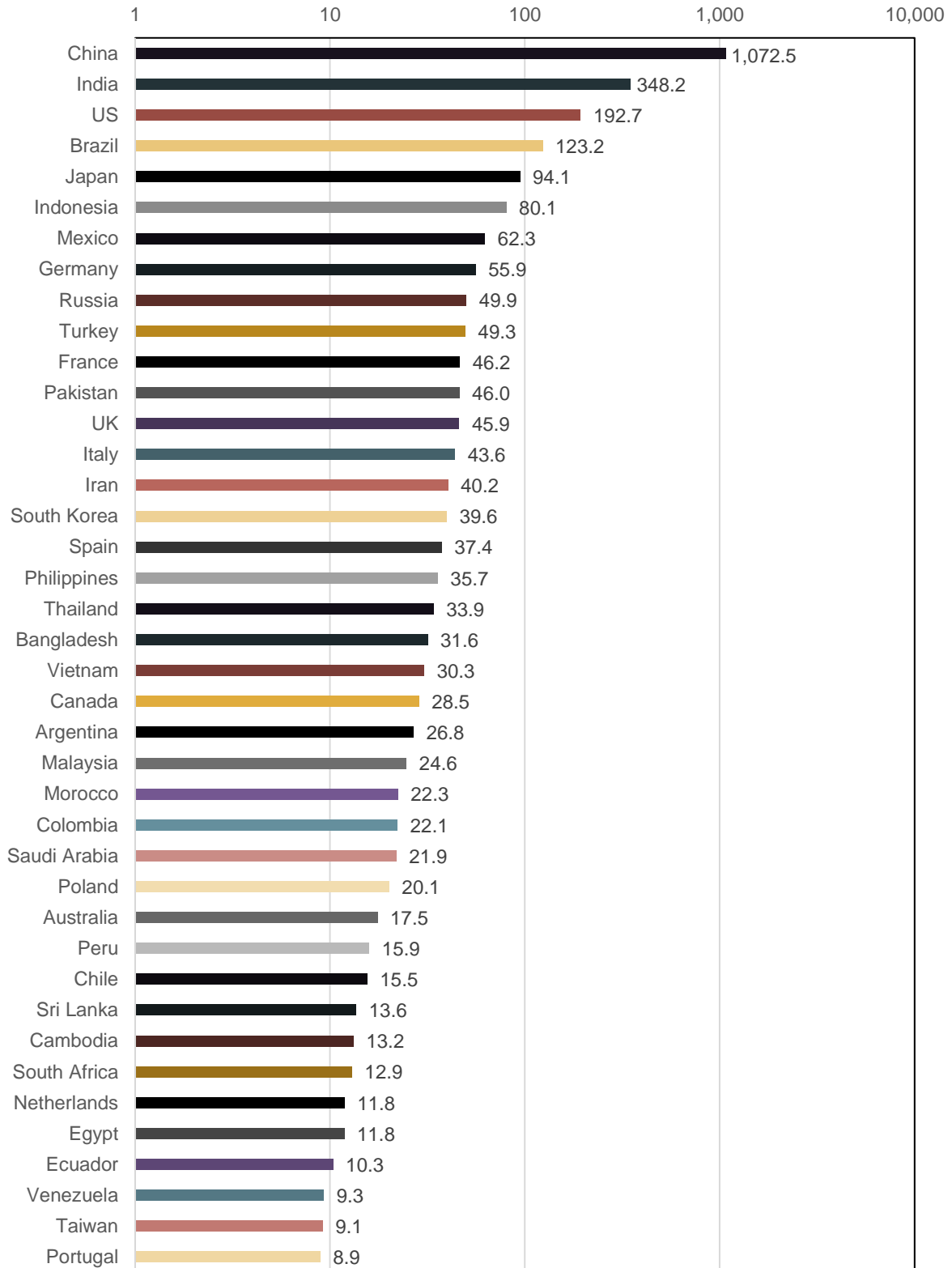

Chart 2. People Fully Vaccinated per 100 Population (Top 20 Countries)



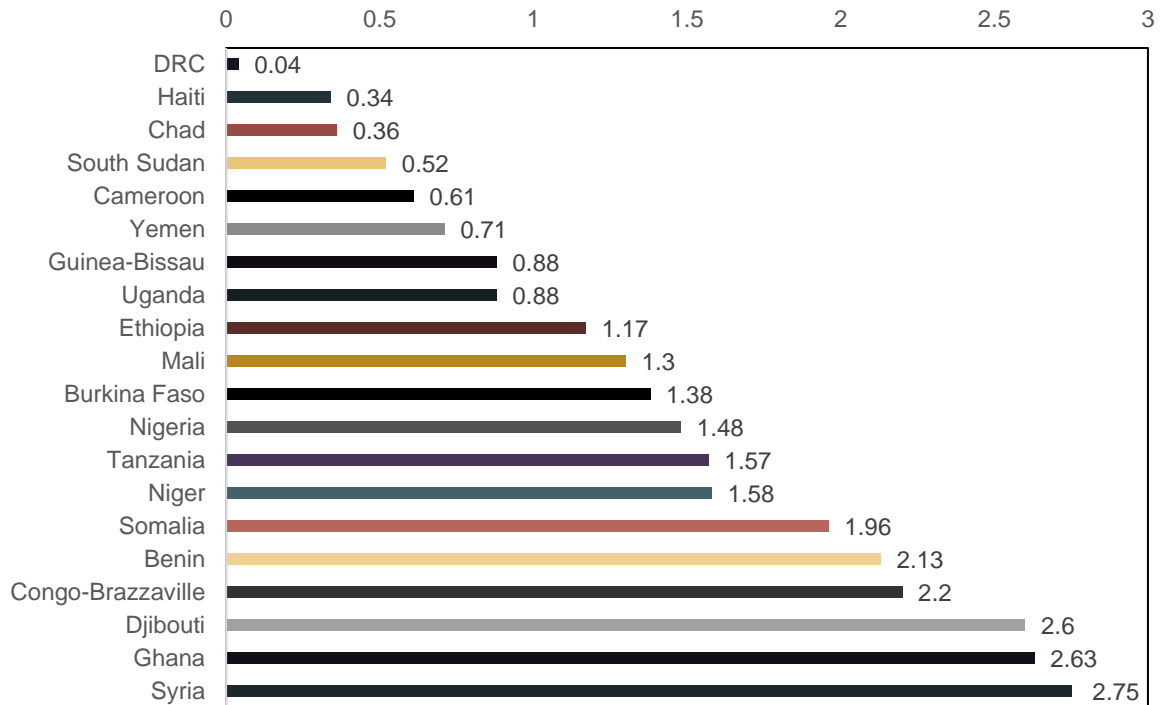

Chart 3. People Fully Vaccinated, Millions (Top 40 Countries)



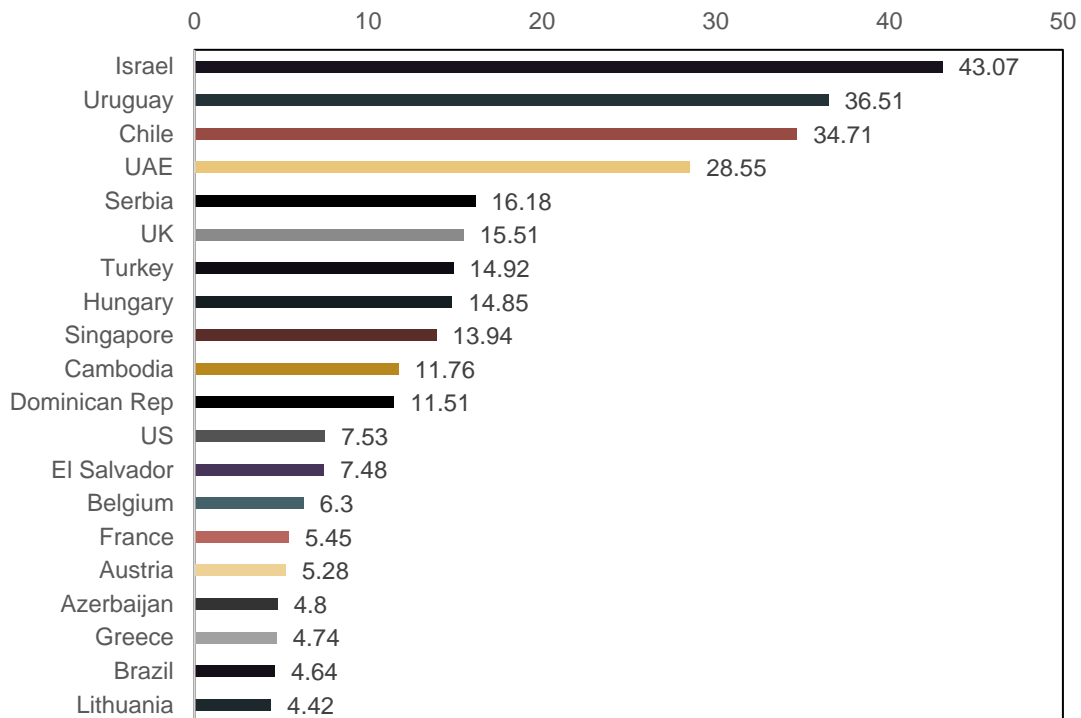

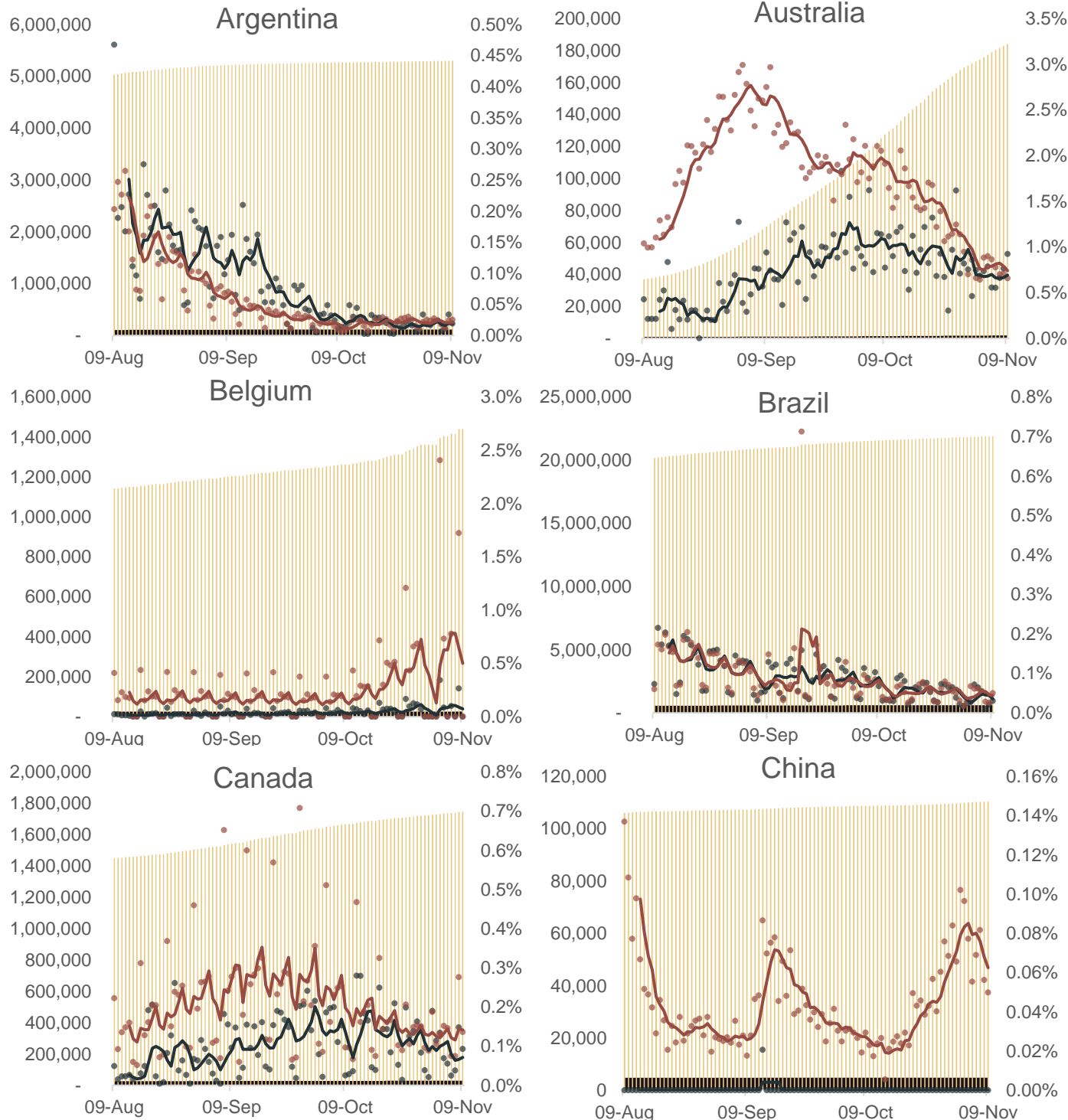

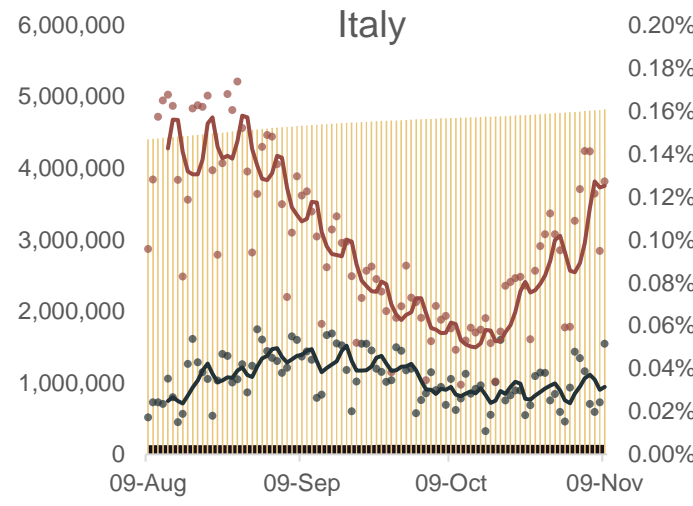
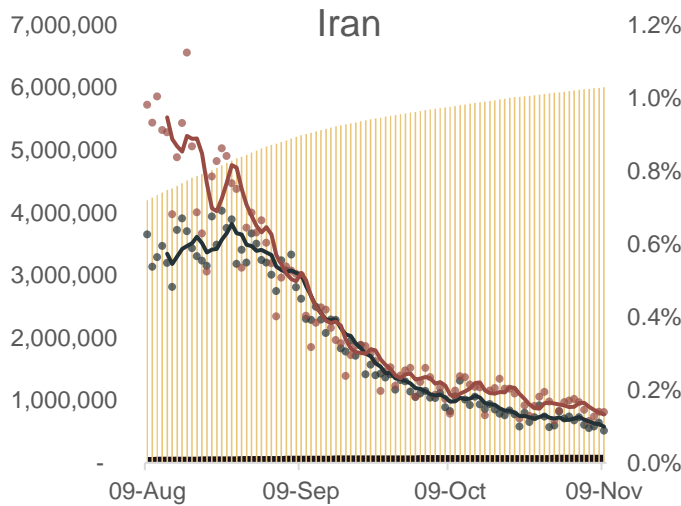
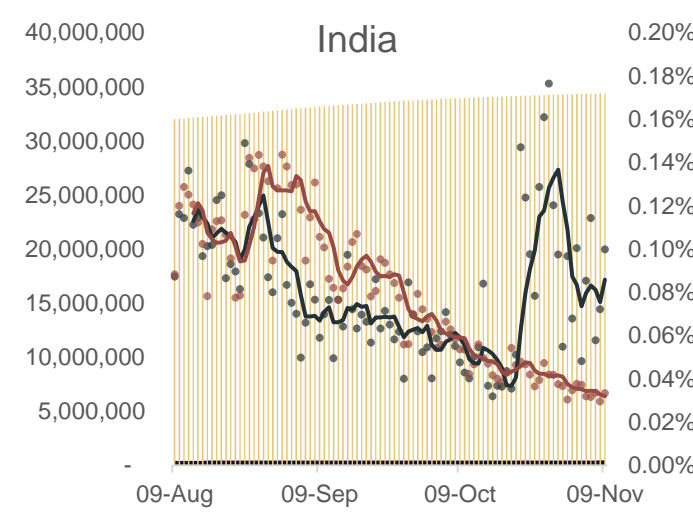
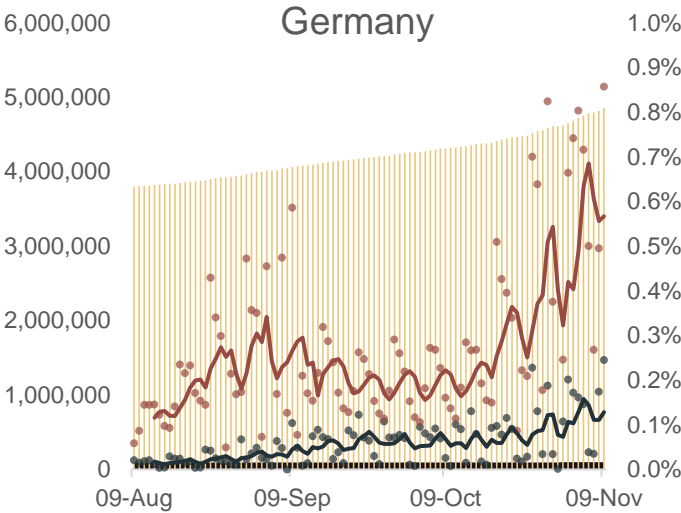
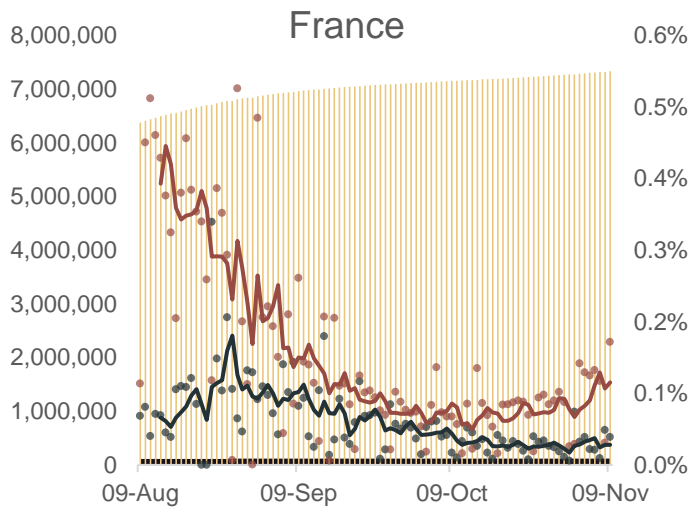
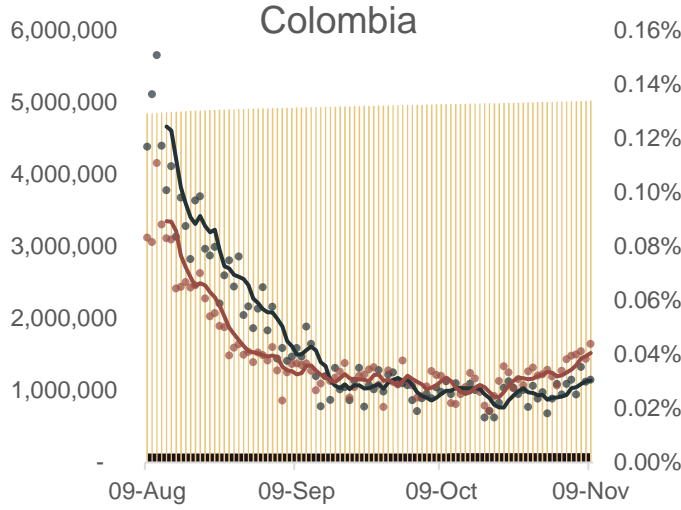
Chart Pack: COVID-19 Cases and Fatalities, Nominal and % Chg Day-to-Day (5dma)

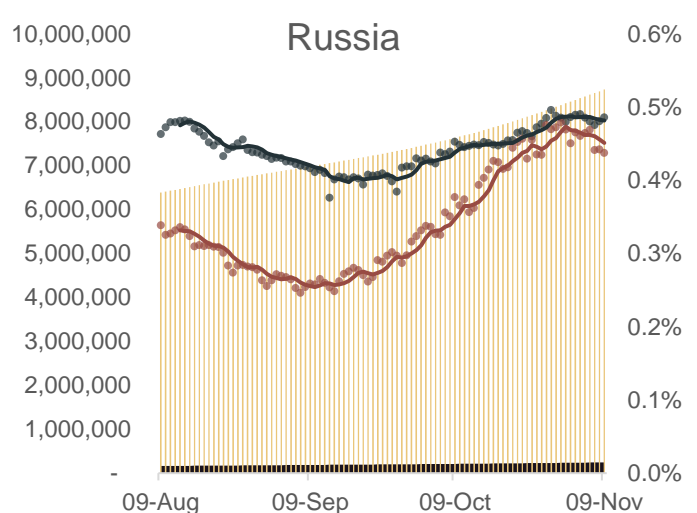

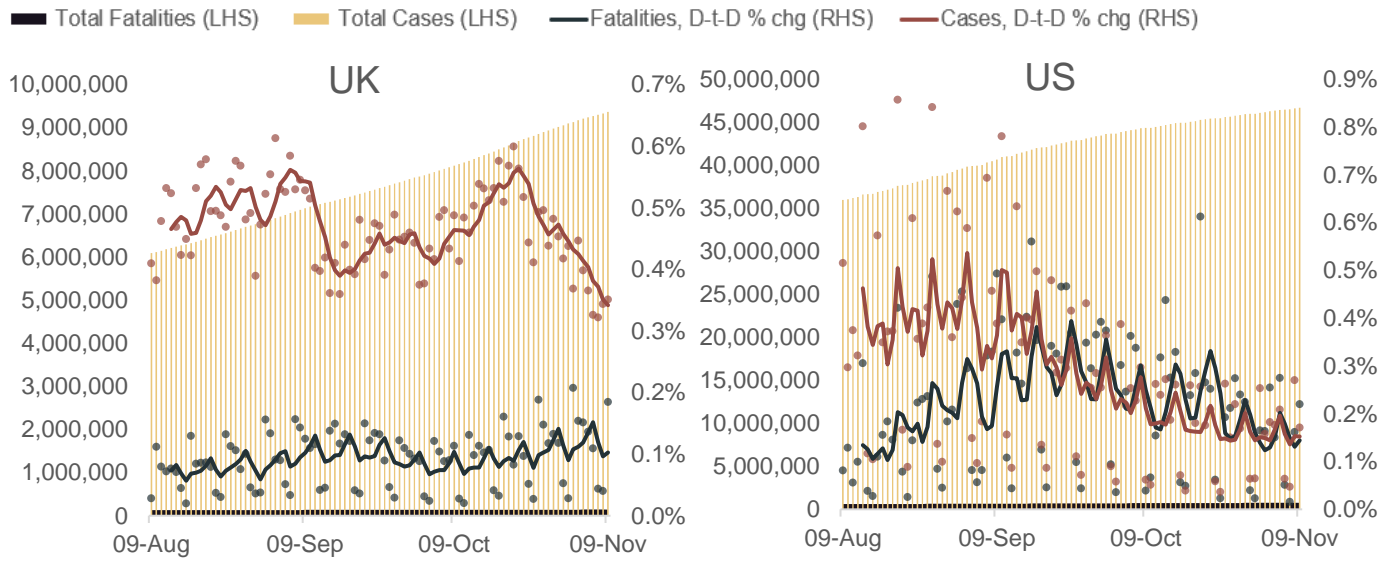

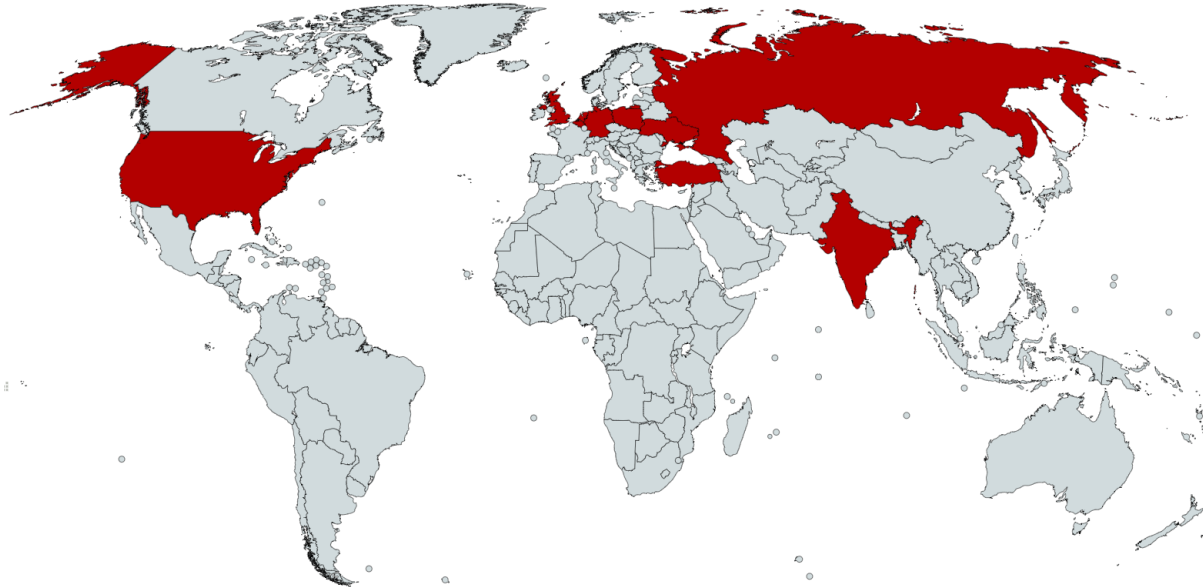

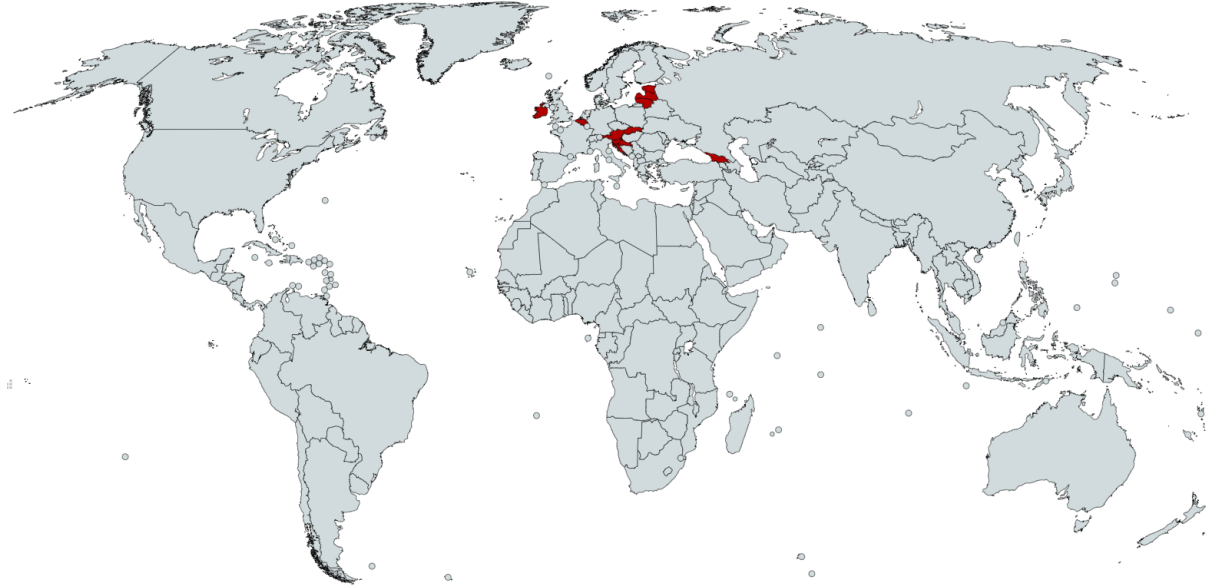

Chart 4. 10 Countries with Highest Number of New Cases in Past Seven Days



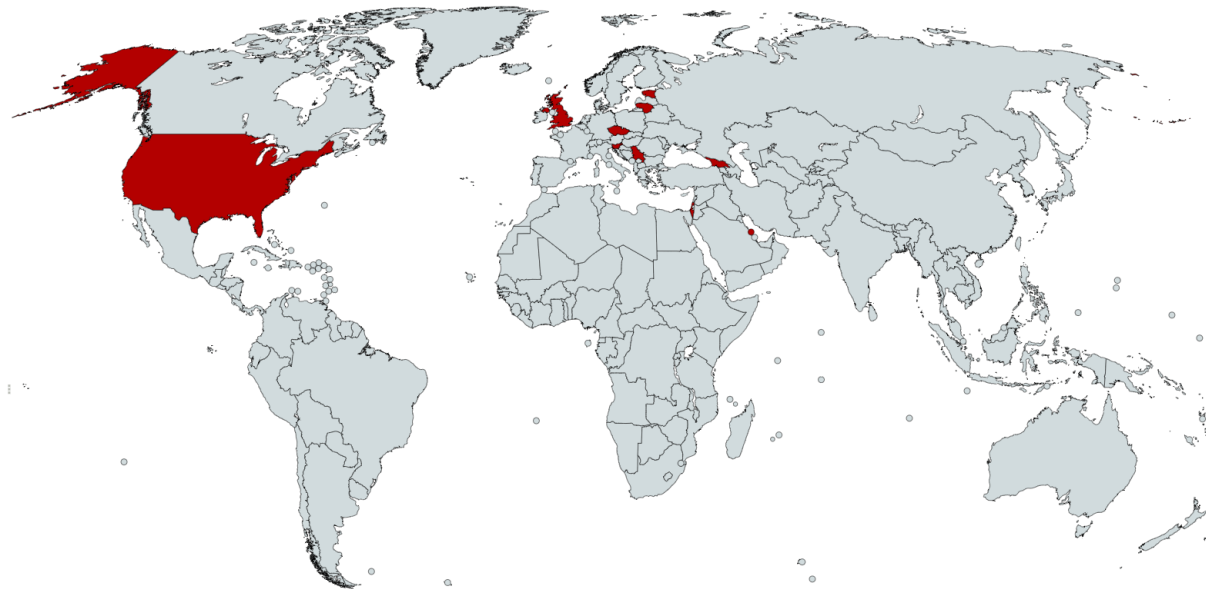

Chart 5. 10 Countries with Highest Number of New Cases Per Capita in Past Seven Days



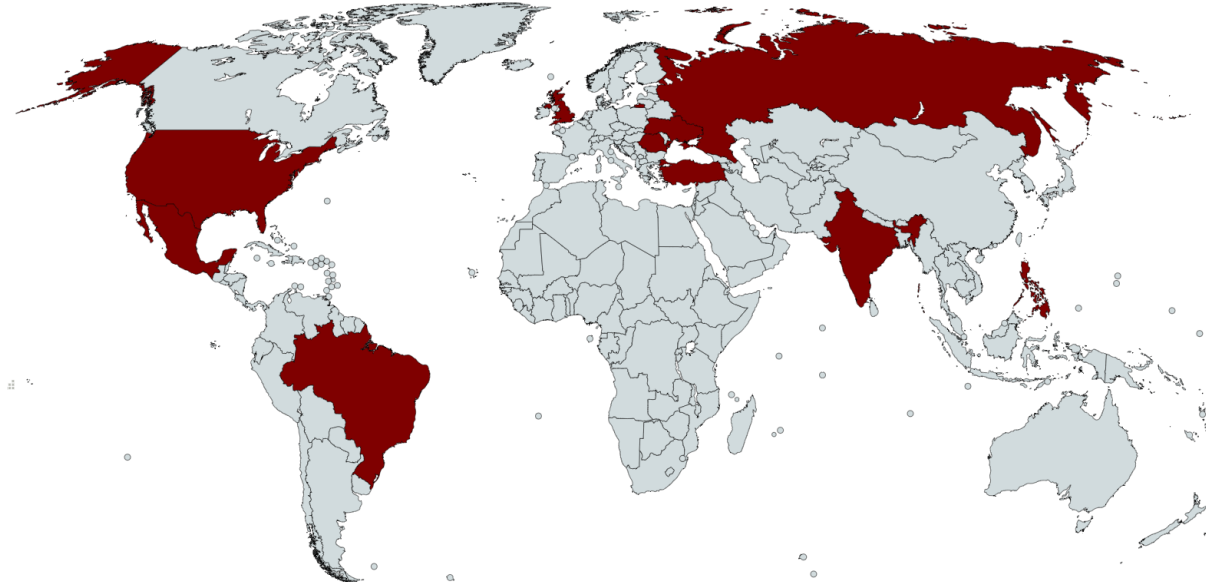

Chart 7. 10 Countries with Highest Number of COVID-19 Related Fatalities in Past Seven Days



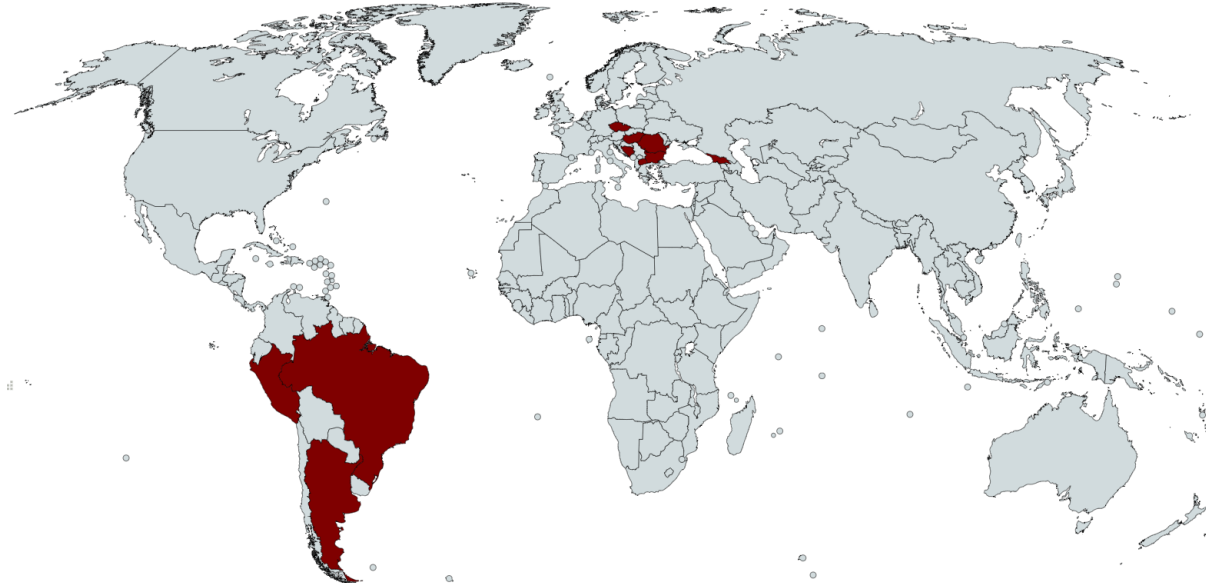
