#### **METHODOLOGY**

This survey was conducted by Echelon Insights, July 30 - August 2, 2024 in English among a sample of N=2,638 Likely Voters in Senate and swing states (N=319 in AZ, N=330 in GA, N=301 in MT, N=321 in MI, N=330 in OH, N=377 in NV, N=330 in PA, N=330 in WI) sampled from the voter file in these states.

The sample was weighted to population benchmarks for registered voters and the 2024 Likely Electorate on gender, age, race/ethnicity, education, region, party, and 2020 presidential vote adjusted for 2024 turnout probability.

Calculated the way it would be for a random sample and adjusted to incorporate the effect of weighting, the margin of sampling error is  $\pm$  2.5 percentage points overall,  $\pm$  7.2 in Arizona,  $\pm$  7.4 in Georgia,  $\pm$  7.6 in Michigan,  $\pm$  6.8 in Montana,  $\pm$  7.0 in Ohio,  $\pm$  6.9 in Nevada,  $\pm$  7.3 in Pennsylvania, and  $\pm$  6.7 in Wisconsin.
